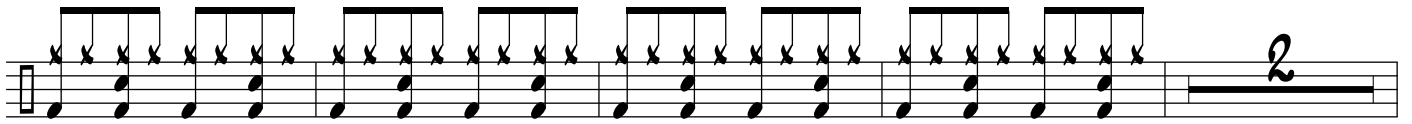
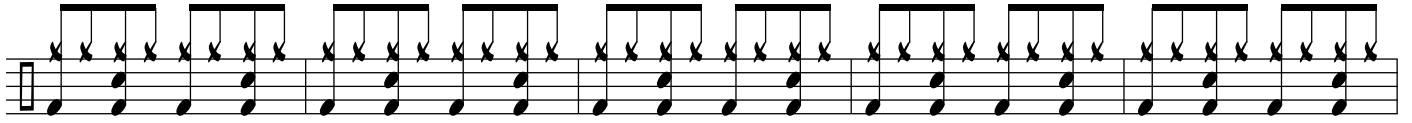
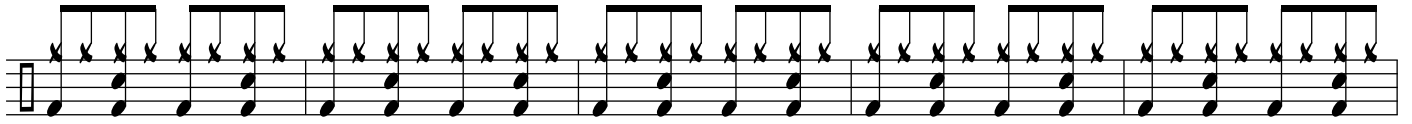
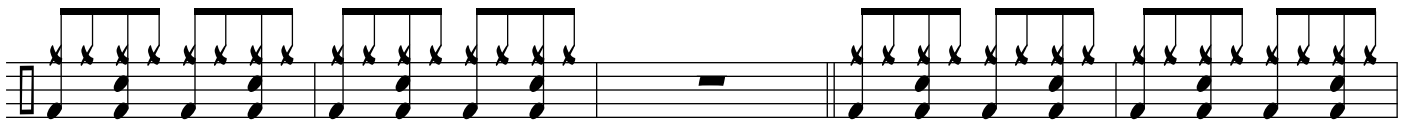
DRUM SET
