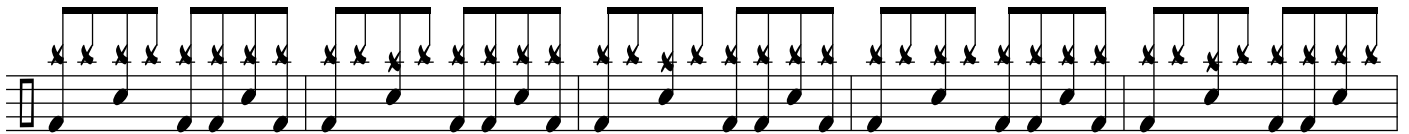
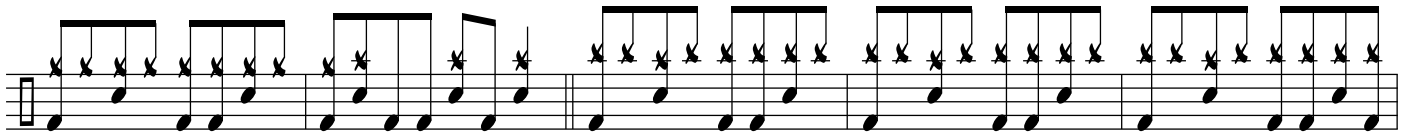
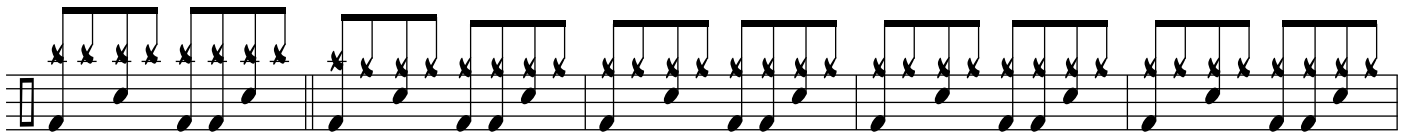
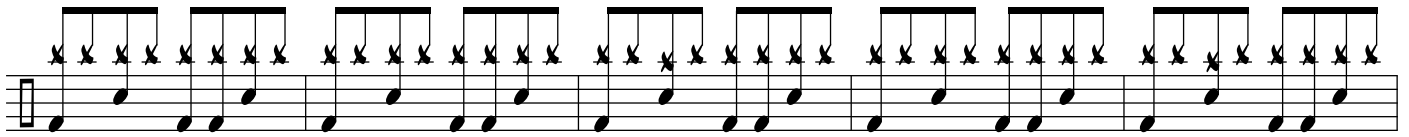
DRUM SET
