

A WARRIOR'S CALL

DRUM SET

The drum set notation is written on a single staff in 4/8 time. It begins with a 4-measure introduction: measures 1 and 3 contain a quarter note followed by a quarter rest, while measures 2 and 4 contain a quarter rest followed by a quarter note. The main piece starts at measure 5 with a continuous eighth-note pattern. The first two lines of the main piece feature a simple eighth-note pattern.
