

# HANGING ON THE TELEPHONE

DRUM SET

Drum set notation for the song "Hanging on the Telephone". The piece is in common time (C) and consists of 33 measures. The notation is organized into six systems, each starting with a measure number. The first system (measures 1-4) begins with a common time signature and a 7-measure rest, followed by a 4-measure pattern of eighth notes with asterisks. The second system (measures 5-8) features a 6-measure rest, a 4-measure eighth-note pattern with asterisks, and a 4-measure rest. The eighth system (measures 33-36) starts with a 4-measure eighth-note pattern with eighth notes, followed by a 4-measure eighth-note pattern with asterisks and a 4-measure rest.
