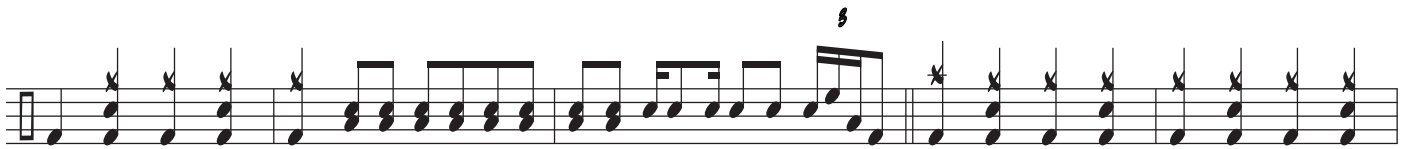
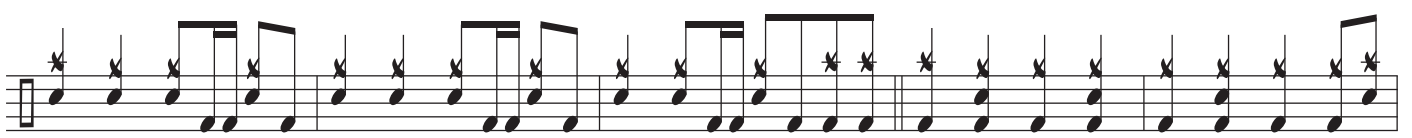
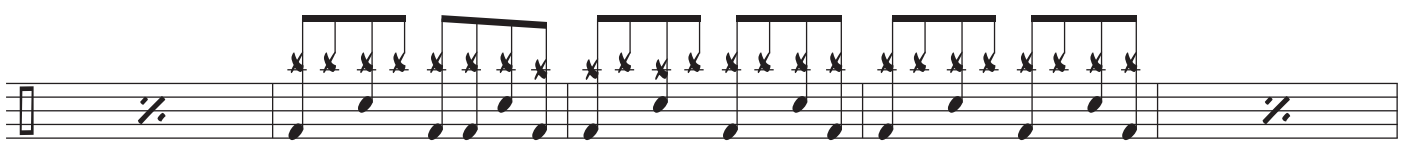
DRUM SET
